

Beaver Lake Permits and Fees

Fishing

1. Beaver Lake is catch-and-release only.
2. A NC fishing license is required.
3. A Beaver Lake fishing permit is required.
 - You can fish any single day for \$5. The daily permit can be obtained and paid for using the self-service box in front of the Warden's office.
 - An annual fishing permit is \$10 for residents and \$100 for non-residents, and can be obtained by appointment with the lake Warden at beaverlakewarden@yahoo.com. Check or cash only.
4. A liability waiver must be completed and can be downloaded from the website.
5. Children under the age of 16 fish for free with a permitted adult.

Boating

1. No fuel powered craft are allowed.
2. No daily permits are available.
3. An annual permit is \$10 for residents and \$100 for non-residents, and can be obtained by appointment with the lake Warden at beaverlakewarden@yahoo.com. Check or cash only.
4. A liability waiver must be completed and can be downloaded from the website.
5. All NC-mandated safe boating practices must be followed, e.g., there must be a PFD in the boat for each passenger and everyone under the age of 16 must wear their PFD.
6. All crafts, canoes, kayaks, paddle boards, etc. must be permitted.

Dogs

1. Asheville City laws regarding animals apply to residents and visitors at the lake or in the neighborhood. Some of these restrictions for dogs include:
 - All dogs must be on leash.
 - Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. (Bags and dog waste receptacles have been installed at the lake for this purpose).
 - Animals may not behave in ways that constitute a public nuisance or endanger others or their property.Violators will be asked to leave, and will be reported to the police or Animal Control Board of the City of Asheville.
2. A permit is required for any dog being walked at the lake.
3. Permits for residents are free of charge. Permits for non-residents are \$100 per dog annually and can be obtained by appointment with the lake warden at beaverlakewarden@yahoo.com. Check or cash only.
4. A liability waiver must be completed and can be downloaded from the website

Note: The Beaver Lake Warden is usually at the office between 4pm and 5pm on weekdays.
